

N/N package. Sirprizeriffic's first foal crop (2004) consisted of 12 live foals, and out of those 12, eight already have impressive show records. But that is the consistency of the Parkinsons--- They were the AQHA Leading Breeders of Halter Horses in 2001, 2002, 2003, just missing the top spot in 2004 by a small margin. As of the beginning of this year they have raised 72 halter horses that have amassed over 5100 halter points, 71 ROMs, 31 Superiors, and 77% are winners and point earners. Again, all these horses are HYPP N/N---apparently not an easy feat in today's halter horse industry.

Although they call Kirkland home, Dorn and Debbie originally lived and worked in Montana. Debbie was a homemaker who fit and conditioned their halter horses and Dorn a business executive. When Dorn retired in 1997 they moved to Arizona to follow their passion of raising and showing great halter horses. Debbie still rides and is currently showing trail and horsemanship as well as other events. Their son Shadd, resides in Scottsdale where he trains and shows reining and cow horses professionally.

Life goes on at the Ranch with the help of Dave Curtis and Benjamin Figueroa fitting and conditioning the halter horses, while Mike Bolton takes charge of the facility which includes an indoor arena, 24 show stalls, 34 mare and foal stalls, a repair facility, three storage buildings and seven residences. Oscar, Jesus and Enrique keep things running smoothly year-round, especially when Dorn and Debbie are on the road to over 20 shows a year.
